9 CR. HRS.

The objective of this program is to prepare and equip ministers for beginning service to the church community. A Certificate of Completion is presented to the student at the end of the one-year program during the summer graduation.

MA 100 - MINISTERS' ACADEMY

SATURDAY 10AM -12PM (2nd & 4th Sat.)

Ministry Seminar Class: **1.5 CR. HRS.**

MN102 - SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES (1ST 6 WEEKS) 1.5 CR. HRS.

MONDAY 6-8:30 PM

Emphasis is placed upon how maturity in Christ can be achieved through the disciplines of Bible reading, fasting, meditation and worship.

PT 102 - HOW TO STUDY THE BIBLE (2ND 6 WEEKS) 1.5 CR. HRS.

MONDAY 6-8:30 PM

This course is designed to teach the basic principles for effective Bible study.

SPRING 2024 GENERAL COURSE OFFERINGS

BNT 211 –THE BOOK OF ACTS 3 CR. HRS.

MONDAY 6-8:30 PM

A study of the “Birth of the Church” and its development as outlined in the Book of Acts. A study of the ministry of the Holy Spirit as manifested in the 1st Century Church. Signs and wonders/Apostles teaching. Application is made for the 21st Century Church.

BNT 112 – NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY I 3 CR. HRS.

TUESDAY 6-8:30 PM

A comprehensive study exploring each New Testament book individually, highlighting the key passages and message. Each book is outlined in its historical and cultural context. Issues involving the formation and authority of the New Testament canon will also be reviewed.

BNT 311 – PAULINE EPISTLES 3 CR. HRS.

TUESDAY 6-8:30 PM

A study of selected letters written by the Apostle Paul with special emphasis given to the student's use of correct hermeneutical principles. The class will examine historical content, customs, setting and application for today.

PT 110 – PRAYER CLINIC (6 WEEKS) 1.5 CR. HRS

MONDAY 6-8:30 PM

A study designed to provide principles and techniques for Intercessory Prayer. Attention will be given to listening to God and following His leadings. One hour classroom time will be dedicated to practical application.

ST 122 – THE APOSTOLIC DOCTRINE (6 WEEKS) 1.5 CR. HRS.

TUESDAY 6-8:30 PM

This course surveys the doctrinal tenets of the Apostolic Church. This class is recommended for New Christians, Youth and Young Adults.

ADVANCED MINISTRY DEVELOPMENT COURSE

BNT 411 – HEBREWS AND THE PRIESTHOOD OF CHRIST

3 CR. HRS.

THURSDAY 6-8:30 PM

A study in the books of Leviticus and Hebrews. The course relates the fulfillment of the Old Testament Priesthood in the person of Jesus Christ.
